Cited for violation of RSA 179:19, VI - allowed gambling and wagering on the premises.

Cited for violation of RSA 179:50, II - did allow the premise to be used for any purpose that was contrary to law.

Date of violations: January 14, 2007.

Recommendation: Settlement reached for an Administrative fine of \$1,500 with \$1,000 held in abeyance for one (1) year contingent upon the licensee's good behavior, the license to sell alcohol suspended for thirty (30) days with all but five (5) days held in abeyance for one (1) year contingent upon the licensee's good behavior commencing July 8, 2007 with re-grant on July 13, 2007, funds seized in the amount of \$901 shall be voluntarily forfeited and used by the NH State Liquor, Bureau of Enforcement & Licensing for the sole purpose of education, training and/or enforcement of the laws and/or administrative rules of the State of New Hampshire, the Licensee acknowledges the above-described funds were knowingly used and/or intended for use by the Licensee in the commission of RSA 179:19, VI, Entertainment & Entertainers, specifically, allowing gambling or wagering on their premises, said activity being in violation of RSA 647:2, Gambling Offenses, and in accordance with paragraph III of said section, said funds are subject to forfeiture, and the Licensee waives the provisions set forth in RSA 595-A:6, Seizure, Custody and Disposition of Articles; Exceptions and understands this matter will be adjudicated before the NH State Liquor Commission and the Bureau of Enforcement & Licensing forbears any criminal prosecution relative to this matter exclusively in the court of jurisdiction.
