

**NHSLC - BUREAU OF ENFORCEMENT - AGENDA**

**WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 29, 2007**

Cited for violation of RSA 179:19, VI - allowed gambling and wagering on the premise.

Date of violation: February 4, 2007.

Recommendation: Settlement reached for a \$1,000

Administrative fine with \$500 held in abeyance for one (1) year contingent upon the Licensee's good behavior, the license to sell alcohol in the canteen only suspended for thirty (30) days with all but two (2) days held in abeyance for one (1) year contingent upon the Licensee's good behavior commencing September 2, 2007 with re-grant on September 4, 2007, funds seized in the amount of \$6,145 shall be voluntarily forfeited by the Licensee to be used for the sole purpose of education, training and/or enforcement of the laws and/or administrative rules of the State of New Hampshire by the Bureau of Enforcement & Licensing, without admitting liability, the Licensee acknowledges the above-described funds are subject to forfeiture pursuant to RSA 179:19, VI and RSA 647:2, the Licensee waives the provisions set forth in RSA 595-A:6 Seizure, Custody and Disposition of Articles; Exceptions, and understands this matter will be adjudicated before the NH State Liquor Commission and the Bureau of Enforcement & Licensing forbears any criminal prosecution, relative to this matter exclusively, in the court of jurisdiction.

**THE COMMISSION APPROVED ALL TERMS OF SETTLEMENT EXCEPT INCREASED THE ADMINISTRATIVE FINE TO \$3,000 WITH \$2,500 SUSPENDED FOR THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED IN THE RECOMMENDATION.**
